

1)) Are the borders with Austria and Slovenia open?

Yes, there is no obstacle at the borders with Austria and Slovenia: the road network is guaranteed to the two foreign countries and also applies to people returning to Italy; there are no interruptions or cancellations regarding transport and airports, public transport operates regularly. There is therefore no difficulty in getting to our territory or returning to your Country. For reliable and always updated information, we recommend visiting the website of your Ministry of Foreign Affairs

2) Are the lifts open?

All six ski resorts in Friuli Venezia Giulia are open and operating. The tracks are perfectly snowy, it has snowed and new snowfalls are expected in the coming days. As additional protection to the skiers, in line with the national provisions, PromoTurismoFVG has decided to adopt a series of measures such as the daily sanitation of the cable cars with alcohol and chlorine-based products and the installation of disinfectant gel dispensers at the ski resorts skipass offices and in all 18 Infopoints in the region.

3) Does Trieste Airport operate regularly?

Yes there are no restrictions and everything is working normally, such the PromoTurismoFVG Infopoint that is open seven days a week for tourists arriving in Friuli Venezia Giulia

4) Are there any restrictions on shop closings / openings? Are bars, restaurants, wineries and agriturismo open?

The commercial activities are open and observe the usual opening hours. Shops, bars, restaurants, wineries and agriturismo continue to carry out regular service.

5) Are the museums and churches open?

Yes all the museums are open. In Trieste the civic museums and the Miramare Castle have the usual opening hours. Catholic churches are open and Masses are resumed. San Spiridione church and San Nicola church are also open only for visits, not for religious functions, and with limited access to small groups of people. The Synagogue and Jewish Museum are open regularly. Basilica and excavations are open in Aquileia, MAN – Museo Archeologico Nazionale is also open from Tuesday. In Palmanova you can visit the Cathedral, the Galleries , open on Saturday and Sunday, and the museum of the Great World War and the Fortress (Friday, Saturday and Sunday 9.00 - 12.00 / Monday 9.00 -12-00 / 13.45 -16.00). In Udine the Cathedral (the museum will reopen on March 10), Museo Diocesano e Gallerie del Tiepolo (Diocesan Museum and Tiepolo Galleries) are open. Civic museums in Udine will be open from Tuesday 3 March. In Cividale del Friuli MAN is open.

6) Is it possible to take guided tours and excursions, ski lessons, sports, etc?

Yes, you can take guided tours outdoors and participate in excursions. Activities by sports facilities, courses and other activities go on, but it is advisable to check timetables and opening hours.

7) Are the ski races confirmed?

Yes, in Friuli Venezia Giulia all the ski races of the federal calendar have been confirmed.

8) In case of difficulty, who can I contact?

The health system of Friuli Venezia Giulia is ready to face and manage the situation: in addition to the telephone number 112 reserved for emergencies, it will also be possible to contact the toll-free number 800 500 300, with trained staff also in English, for clarifications and explanations on the behavioral indications provided by the ministerial order. For tourist information on the territory, it is possible to refer to over 60 information points in

9) Are the events in the spring at seaside resorts confirmed?

Yes the main events are confirmed in Grado and Lignano Sabbiadoro and the first one to open the spring season is the “Festa delle Cape” (Mussels Festival) which will take place regularly as scheduled from 7 to 8 March and from 14 to 15 March. The PromoTurismoFVG website is constantly updated and the two seaside resorts are preparing for the long Easter weekend to offer resident and tourist different opportunities.

10) Can I confirm beach holidays during Easter time at the seaside?

Yes, the accommodations are open and you can enjoy the spring season with the milder temperatures for excursions and outdoor activities. From e-bike to walks, from the sea to the lagoon, the seaside resorts offer different opportunities to enjoy the sun and take a relaxing break surrounded by nature. For further information the Infopoints in Grado and Lignano Sabbiadoro are open again seven days a week from Monday 2 March.
